The Person of the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is a Person with the attribute of a person. He is the Third Person of the Godhead and is just as much a Person as the Father or the Son. All the emotions, personality and attributes ascribed to a person are manifest in the Holy Spirit. Recognition of and a total dependence upon the Holy Spirit is unquestionable one of the great priorities in the Body of Christ today.

A person is an intelligent, free will, living entity, someone possessing personal properties, having a character, able to think and speak (John 16:7,8)

1. The Holy Spirit is Omniscient: (I Cor. 2:10-11; John 16:12): He Knows everything
2. The Holy Spirit is Omnipotent: (Luke 1:35): He has All Power
3. The Holy Spirit is Omnipresent: (John 16:16,17); Psalm 139:7-10: He is everywhere.
4. The Holy Spirit is understanding, intelligent, wise (I Cor. 2:10-11): Ability to learn; judge; make decision: give personal opinion or proper interpretation
5. The Holy Spirit can speak- see and hear (Matt. 10:19-20; Acts 13:2; I Tim. 4:1; Rev. 2:7)
6. The Holy Spirit has a will (I Cor. 12:11): The ability to choose and/or decides a course of action
7. The Holy Spirit has emotions (Eph. 4:30; Romans 15:30): Feelings of sorrow, happy, hate, sadness
8. The Holy Spirit teaches (John 14:26): To show/to explain/to give instruction-to give information
9. The Holy Spoke to New Testament Leaders (Acts 8:29; 10:19; 13:2)
10. He give instruction, command authority (Acts 13:2)
11. The Holy Spirit intercedes; (Romans 8:16-17): To plead on another's behalf; Praying to God for someone else.
12. The Holy Spirit gives us access to God: (Eph. 2:18): Approach, make entry; and admission
13. He can be blasphemed against: (Matt. 12:30-31) Blasphemy as **“insulting, cursing, lacking reverence for God, claiming deity.”**

14. He can be resisted (Acts 7:51): To withstand the action; oppose; to remain firm against an action.
15. He can be quenched (I Thess 5:19): To put out; to suppress; snuff out.
16. He can be grieved (Romans 8:26): To ache; sorrow; to suffer-to take it hard
17. He can be tempted (Acts 5:9) Won over; seduced; under a spell; lead on
18. The Holy Spirit can be lied to (Acts 5:3,4) Falsehood; not true
19. The Holy Spirit can be insulted: (Hebrews 6:4-6; 10:26-29): Cursed; mocked; offended; and dishonored
20. The Holy Spirit can be vexed (Psalms 78:40; Isa. 63:10): Upset; annoy; agitated; depress, displeasure.
21. The Holy Spirit can be fellowshiped (Phil 2:4; II Cor. 13:14): Keep company with; Maintain a deep friendship
22. The Holy Spirit is our Comforter (John 15:26): Consoler; A Friend; a person that comforts.
23. The Holy moves on people's hearts (II Peter 1:21): He is a heart changer-He speaks to the heart of people.
24. The Holy Spirit is our Guide (John 16:13): He leads; Maneuver; educate, instructs; pioneer, and pilot
25. The Holy Spirit leads (Romans 8:14)
26. The Holy Spirit witnesses (Romans 8:16) A Watcher; An Observer; to give evidence
27. The Holy Spirit testifies (John 15:26): To put forward; to present; to stand up for:
28. The Holy Spirit creates life (John 3:5) To give life to; bring into being; to produce-to make happen:
29. The Holy Spirit controls (Acts 16:6-7): To constrain; to collect; to hold back
30. The Holy Spirit makes intercession (Romans 8:27): Praying for you and me
31. The Holy Spirit is the Justifier and Sanctifier (I Cor. 6:11) Justifier means to make good; to stand up for; to promote; to defend: Sanctifier means to hold in the highest esteem; to be set apart; to cleanse, consecrate and dedicate:
32. He is referred to the masculine personal pronoun "He." (John 14:16, 26)
33. The Holy Spirit is called God: (Acts 5:3,4)
34. Jesus was led up of the Spirit into the wilderness: Matt. 4:1, God, the Son, submits to another member of the Trinity.
35. He distributes at will His manifestations: (I Cor. 12:11)
36. He was part of the Creation: (Job 26:13)
